A RESOLUTION OF SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 20 (DESMET), MISSOULA COUNTY, SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE DISTRICT THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE BOARD SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO EXPAND THE USES TO WHICH NET REVENUES FROM THE SALE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY MAY BE APPLIED

RECITALS

WHEREAS, by election conducted on November 5, 2019 (the "Prior Election"), the qualified electors of School District No. 20 (DeSmet), Missoula County, Montana (the "District") authorized the Board of Trustees of the District (the "Board") to sell to willing buyers at market prices lots or parcels owned by the District legally described in the recital below to produce net revenues to apply toward debt service on school district bonds that finance costs of an addition to DeSmet School (the "Project") or otherwise offset costs of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the land in the District that the District is authorized to sell by the Prior Election consists of approximately 10 acres in total, is located just north of the DeSmet School grounds, and is more particularly described as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 13-19-104, M.C.A., the election to authorize the additional uses to which of net revenues may be applied can be conducted by a mail ballot election; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of the District as follows:

- election to be held in the District on February 23, 2021, which date is not less than 70 days after the date of passage of this resolution, such election to be conducted by mail ballot pursuant to the provisions of the Mail Ballot Act, for the purpose of voting on the question of whether the Board, in addition to applying the net revenues from the sale of the District property toward debt service on school district bonds that finance costs of the Project or otherwise offsetting costs of the Project, shall be authorized to apply the net revenues produced by the sale of lots or parcels owned by the District toward any other lawful expenditure of the District, including, but not limited to (i) costs of building on the DeSmet School grounds a multiuse field and track, and (ii) fees or costs incurred by the District relating to zoning, land use, or other rules or regulations or laws that limit the uses to which property in the District may be put, including, without limitation, fees and costs of attorneys and experts.
- 2. <u>Conduct of Election</u>. All qualified electors of the District shall be entitled to vote at the election described herein. Pursuant to Section 20-20-201, M.C.A., the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of the call and details of this election and to provide this resolution to the Missoula County Election Administrator no less than three (3) days after this resolution is passed. The District Clerk is directed to instruct the Missoula County Election Administrator to close registration and thereafter prepare printed lists of the electors in the District entitled to vote in the election in the District in the form and manner prescribed by law and consistent with the Mail Ballot Plan. The County Election Administrator shall prepare the ballot and arrange for the printing of the ballot and conduct the election in accordance with all legal requirements.
- Rotice of Election. The County Election Administrator is hereby authorized and requested to cause notice of the call and holding of the election to be given at least three times no earlier than 40 days and no later than 10 days before the election, in the *Missoulian*, a newspaper of general circulation in the District, and the District Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause the notice to be posted at three public places in the District, with at least one notice being posted in each ward or precinct in the District, and, if the District has a website, is directed to post notice on the District's website for 10 days prior to the election.
