Often times, a <i>district attorney</i> is called a DA. I might say that the <i>district attorney</i> put the criminals on trial and then sent them to jail. <i>District attorneys</i> are also called prosecutors.	seize (vowel team) Seize is a verb that means to take hold of something suddenly and forcibly. I might say that I <i>seized</i> the remote for the television before another family member could get it. You can also use the word figuratively. You might hear someone tell you to <i>seize</i> the day, which would mean to make good use of your day instead of waiting for another time.	hum · ble (closed, C-le) Humble is an adjective that means not overly proud. I might say that the <i>humble</i> celebrity did not want to draw attention to himself in public. <i>Humbly</i> is the adverb form. You might <i>humbly</i> ask to join a team or club simply to participate, not because you want to be a show-off.	ap · point · ed (closed, vowel team, suffix) Appointed is a verb that means assigned a job or role to someone. Remember that <i>-ed</i> is a suffix that tells us this is the past tense form of the verb. <i>Appoint</i> is the present tense form. I might say that the student <i>was appointed</i> president of the student council. A coach might need to <i>appoint</i> a new team captain if the current captain gets injured and can no longer play.
pros · e · cute (closed, irregular, VCe) Prosecute is a verb that means to carry on a legal action against a person accused of a crime in court. <i>Prosecutor</i> and <i>prosecution</i> are both noun forms of the word. A <i>prosecutor</i> is a lawyer who brings charges against criminals, puts them on trial, and tries to send them to jail. <i>Prosecution</i> can refer to a group of lawyers on a case, or it can refer to the act of carrying on a legal action against a criminal in court.
